Examples of a Proof:

***BIRTH RECORD** of SMITH, JOHN, born 1869, Thurlow Township, Hastings County, Ontario, parents SMITH, Peter and EVERETT, Martha.*

OR

***DEATH RECORD** of ... (as above).*

OR

ANY-FAITH CHURCH MARRIAGE RECORD of ... (as above) ANY-CHURCH BAPTISMAL RECORD... (as above)

OR

***OTHER PRIMARY PROOF**, as available.*

NOTES:

- 1) *Census, newspaper announcements, and published accounts of local history are **SECONDARY PROOFS** and can be used together only when **PRIMARY** proofs cannot be found despite a thorough search.*
- 2) *Information found within the online **LOYALIST DIRECTORY** and the published **Loyalist Lineages books** is not in itself a Primary Proof. These are resources to be used towards locating additional information and the primary proofs.*
- 3) *The **BRANCH GENEALOGIST** will assist with all stages of your Certificate Application Process.*
