The last exec meeting (Mar 21, 1985) a discussion was held about a permanent home, somewhere to set up a library. They wrote to the city asking about space at the old Ottawa Teachers College. Letters to be sent to other heritage groups about forming a lobby group to ask for space

Don Holmes wrote about the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association marksman trophy. Sir Guy Carleton raised the funds to purchase the medals for the 'United Empire Trophy,' including a history of the trophy
